SCRIPTURE: Matthew 28

LESSON: Jesus' Resurrection



INTRO

Parents say to your kid(s) - Last week we ended our story on the sad events that Jesus had died on the cross. BUT, that wasn't the end to Jesus' story! Today we are going to see how Jesus didn't stay dead! He rose from the dead and is alive!

Go and Tell- Choose one child to "go and tell" two children, "Jesus is alive!" After the child tells the two children the message, they will sit back down. The two children who have heard the message will each go and tell two more children the same message then sit down. Continue telling the message until all children are sitting down. Lead the group to say "Jesus is alive!" together. Play again as time allows.

Parents Say: You all worked together to spread the good news so everyone would know Jesus rose from the dead and is alive!



LESSON - JESUS' RESURRECTION

Story Point #1: (Kids repeat!)

Jesus appeared to Mary! (Kids repeat!)

Mary and the disciples were sad and confused after Jesus died. They couldn't understand what happened.. When Mary went to the tomb where Jesus was buried, she saw the stone had been rolled away. She was shocked! Peter and John came and looked inside the tomb and saw the cloths Jesus was wrapped in, but Jesus was not there! Suddenly, Jesus appeared to Mary, but she didn't recognize Him! He asked her why she was crying - and she asked Him where He had taken Jesus. He looked at her and said her name, "Mary!" At that moment, she knew, Jesus was alive! How happy she must have been! He told her to run back and tel the disciples that He was alive and going back to te Father !

Christ Connection! (Kids repeat!)

Jesus rose from the dead and is alive! (Kids repeat!)

Jesus's death took away our punishment from sin. He did not deserve to die, but did that for us because He loves us SO MUCH. Jesus knew He would come to the earth to die in our place. He trusted His Father God that His plan was perfect. Jesus died, but we can celebrate that God miraculously raised Him from the dead! He is more powerful than death! When we believe and trust in what Jesus did for us, he promises to take away all of our sin and give us new life! Let's celebrate that He is alive!



RESPONSE

Pray: God, you are incredible! You raised Jesus from the dead and had a plan to conquer sin through Jesus! Thank you for sending Jesus to save us and bring us life! Help us to never forget what Jesus did for us on the cross and the power He holds!

Discuss:

- What stood out to you from this story?
- Who went to the tomb on the third day after Jesus died on the cross? *Jesus' friend Mary*
- What did Peter and John see in the tomb? *The cloths that had been wrapped around Jesus' body.*
- What did Jesus tell Mary to do? *Go and tell the others that He was alive and going back to the Father*
- Does anyone have any questions? Was anything about this lesson confusing?
 - *Allow time for questions and if you don't know the answers, that's okay. Affirm their question and let them know that you don't know but will try to find out.*
