SCRIPTURE: 2 Corinthians 11

LESSON: Guarding the Truth

INTRO



Say - Today we will talk about how Paul traveled around telling people about Jesus and how to live like Him. In our Bibles we can read some of the letters Paul wrote to the churches he was visiting! Let's hear about one today!

Going on a trip - Have children sit in a circle. Ask them to think of some things they would pack if they were going on a trip. Go around the room and have each child say what they would bring on their trip.

Say - I wonder what Paul packed when he traveled to many places to tell people about Jesus. Maybe he took paper and something to write with so he could write his letters to the churches. Paul wrote the church in Colossae to tell them God helps us live like Jesus. When we trust in Jesus, God changes us to be like Him. Jesus wants us to turn away from our old way of living and live in a way that honors Him.

Story Point #1: (Kids repeat!)

The people were not following Jesus like they should! (Kids Repeat)

Paul had been sharing the good news with lots of people in a place called Corinth.. After he left, they started listening to many new teachers who were teaching things that were untrue. Paul loved these people and wanted them to follow Jesus. He was disappointed that they were listening to the lies of these new teachers, so he wrote them a letter. Paul wrote, "I will not stop telling you this: Those teachers are sharing a message that is not true. They are trying to stop the good news about Jesus from spreading. Those teachers do not love God."

Christ Connection! (Kids repeat!)

God wants us to follow Him only! (Kids repeat!)

We are going to have lots of people teaching us things throughout our lives! We must remember to listen to God's Word and do what it says. When we pray we can ask God to help us obey God, even when we want to listen to people in the world who are saying things that go against what He says. God wants believers to obey Him only!



RESPONSE

Sing: [First Place in Everything](#) (Key Passage Song)
[James 1:5](#)

Pray: Jesus, thank you that you died to set us free. Thank you for how much you love us and help us to love others that way. Help us to be more like You. Amen.

Discuss:

- Who told the people in Corinth about Jesus? *Paul*
- Were the new teachers teaching the people the truth? No, they were teaching untrue things
- What are some ways we can live like Jesus? *Examples: Forgive people, obey our parents, do not lie, be gentle and patient*
- *Allow time for questions and if you don't know the answers, that's okay. Affirm their question and let them know that you don't know but will try to find out.*

BONUS ACTIVITIES

Coloring Sheet - [Printable Coloring Sheet](#)

Stand Together - Invite the class to stand side-by-side with about two feet between each kid. Challenge them to stand on one foot. You may time them to see how long they can stay standing on one foot. After the last kid loses balance, play again, allowing the kids to place hands on shoulders to hold one another steady.

Say - One of the ways God gives us this power is through the Holy Spirit, but God also gives us one another. Other believers can help you stand up for the gospel just as you can help one another stand on one foot longer. We help one another by studying God's Word together, confessing sin to one another, encouraging one another, and meeting one another's needs.
