SCRIPTURE: John 4

LESSON: Jesus and the Samaritan Woman

INTRO



Parents say to your kid(s) - Today we will see just how much Jesus loves all people. He knows everything about us and in our story today we'll see how he knew everything about a woman he met at a well.

Honor One Another - Sit in a circle as a family and explain that you will practice "honoring" each other. Everyone will say something they love about someone else in the family, reminding children to use kind, respectful words.

SAY • The Bible teaches us to show honor to one another because all people are made in God's image. In today's Bible story, we will hear about a woman who probably did not feel special. In fact, she was surprised when Jesus spoke kindly to her! Listen to the Bible story to hear how Jesus showed love to the woman.

LESSON - JESUS AND THE SAMARITAN WOMAN

Story Point #1! (Kids repeat!)
Jesus loves all people! (Kids repeat!)

A lot of people may not have thought this Samaritan woman was very special. But Jesus loves all people and knows that everyone needs a Savior. She told Jesus she was waiting for the Messiah. Can you imagine how excited she must have been when he told her *He* was the Messiah? Jesus loved the Samaritan woman just like he loves YOU!

Christ Connection! (Kids repeat!)
Jesus knew what the Samaritan woman needed and He knows what we need! (Kids repeat!)

Have you ever been so thirsty? You probably drank some water, right? But then a little later, you were probably thirsty again. Jesus told the woman about "Living Water" and told the woman that if she drank this "Living Water" she would never be thirsty again! Jesus wasn't talking about actual water, but He was talking about God's Spirit. He gives us His Spirit when we believe in Him - and we will always have what we need. Jesus knew what she needed and He knows your needs as well. He is able to provide in every way possible!

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RESPONSE

Discuss:

- What stood out to you from this story?
- What is the living water Jesus talked about? *God's Spirit*
- What did Jesus say He is? *The Messiah*

- *Allow time for questions and if you don't know the answers, that's okay. Affirm their question and let them know that you don't know but will try to find out.*

Plants

Look at various plants in or outside of your house. Ask children what they think a plant needs to grow? Talk about the things a plant needs, such as water, sunlight, and soil on.
