LESSON: Jesus Healed a Man Who

Was Blind

INTRO



Parents say to your kid(s) - We've seen Jesus do some pretty incredible things in the past few weeks. Today Jesus will meet a man who was blind from the time he was a baby and do something only Jesus can do!

"Build Blindfolded" - Set a few blocks in front of your child and invite them to build with the blocks either wearing a blindfold or closing their eyes. When the child is finished with the structure, encourage her to remove the blindfold or open her eyes. Ask If the structure looks the way she wanted it.

Parents say: The man in our Bible story today may have had hard time doing things he wanted to do because he was blind. Let's see how Jesus helps him in our Bible Story!



LESSON - JESUS HEALED A MAN WHO WAS BIIND

Watch the Bible story video: Jesus healed a man who was blind

Story Point #1! (Kids repeat!)

Jesus healed a man who could not see! (Kids repeat!)

Jesus' disciples thought the blind man did something wrong to be born blind. Jesus told them that was not the case at all! He said he was born blind so that God could show them His power through healing him. Only Jesus can heal people and give them their sight. The man was amazed and wanted to know who Jesus was. Jesus told him he was the Son of God and he believed in Him and worshiped him.

Christ Connection! (Kids Repeat!)

Jesus can open our eyes! (Kids Repeat!)

Our sin keeps us from seeing what is true about God. It keeps our hearts from seeing what God wants us to do. Jesus came as light into a dark world. He helps us see what is true so we can know God. Praise God that Jesus came to take away our sin on the cross. We may not be blind when it comes to seeing with our eyes, but Jesus can open our eyes to see Him at work all around us and through us!



RFSPONSF

Sing: By His Wounds (Current Key Passage Song)

Good Good Father



Discuss:

- What did Jesus do for the man? He healed him!
- How can Jesus help us? He saved us by dying on the cross. Through that he can give us anything we need to help in any situation. Comfort, peace, strength, joy!

Does anyone have any questions? Was anything about this lesson confusing?

- Allow time for questions and if you don't know the answers, that's okay.
 Affirm their question and let them know that you don't know but will try to find out.
