Memory Verse:

One Big Thing:

Jesus teaches us to rely on God for everything.

Review:

This week, we learned about Jesus’ instructions on prayer. Jesus reminds us to rely on God for our every need. We read the account of God giving His people manna in the desert (Exodus 16) and were reminded that like them, we can ask and trust God to provide the things we truly need.

Challenge:

Spend time journaling each day while memorizing the Lord’s prayer over the next three weeks.

Below are some journaling prompts designed to help kids understand the meaning of the Lord's Prayer.

Day 1:

What is a job you think God would like you to do when you grow up? Draw it and ask God to help you choose the career that is best.

Day 2:

What is something you think God would like you to learn how to do when you grow up? Draw yourself doing it and ask God to help you get there.

Day 3:

What is something that's really hard for you to do now? Draw yourself doing it and ask God to help you get better at it.

Day 4:

What is something you're worried about or scared of? Draw it and ask God to help you trust Him and to take the worry and fear away.

Day 5:

What is something that you or your family need? Draw it and ask God to provide it.
