## PRACTICE

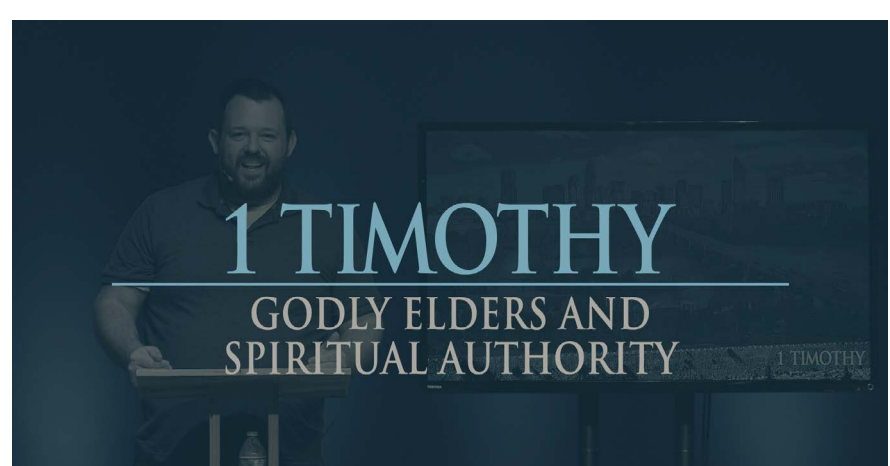
### Confess Together
